

MFL – French Learning Pathway

Key stage 2

Despite Modern Foreign Languages starting in KS2, the framework builds on the Early Learning Goals embedded during the foundation stage. In particular, Communication and Language ' *Listening and attention: children listen attentively in a range of situations. They listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events and respond to what they hear with relevant comments, questions or actions. They give their attention to what others say and respond appropriately, while engaged in another activity.* '

Introduced at the beginning on KS2, children will develop a awareness of the French language. They will learn basic words initially, developing onto full sentences and sentence structure towards the end of KS2. Children will hopefully enjoy learning languages through relaxed teaching sessions which will encourage them to learn French further, and possibly other languages, at secondary schools.
