Of course, our plans will be weather dependent, but our plan is as follows.

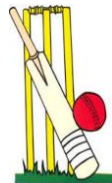
- 10.30am-11.30am Fireflies and year 2

UV Protection

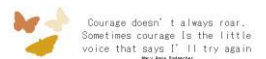
